BFAC Notes – Shire of Plantagenet – 8th May 2024

1. Fire Season Review

- Relatively quiet across region
- Local fires well managed at local level.
- Some deployments intra-region and inter-region Serpentine, Neds Corner, Waroona & Walpole.
- Thank Plantagenet assistance epitomises our culture of 'helping a mate'
- Neds Corner Fatality Findings/recommendations still to be finalised when released recommend analysis and see what applies to Plantagenet.

2. School and Community Group – Evacuations

- All schools are required to have bushfire plan.
- Schools will act upon advice given by someone substantial at the fire.
- Be aware of need to go early particularly when larger groups involved schools, hospitals etc

3. AFDRS Review

- A representative from AFDRS was at ROAC in April –
- System continues to be reviewed and monitored if glitches are observed please take opportunity to provide feedback.

4. Mitigation Works

- Shire has a Bushfire Risk Management Plan.
- Allow shire to access funding to mitigate shire tenure land. .
- UCL/UMR in gazetted townsites DFES responsibility. Have worked with Chris Norton at Narrikup to do some work around that townsite.
- Met with Mount Barker townsite 'burn group' about 6 weeks ago to integrate into burn plan for Mount Barker townsite.
- All mitigation strategies on the table just need advanced planning to ensure clearances are obtained.

5. Training

- Legal and Legislation recommend completion when all FCO appointments are finalised.
- Opportunity to pursue higher order courses including incident management.
- Crew Leader
- Advanced Bushfire
- Sector Commander
- Incident Controller Level 1 pause this one pending refinement
- Pre-season shakedown desktop exercise.

6. Permits

- Recommend permit holder notify Comcen may reduce false alarms to brigades.
- Gazetted Fire Weather Officers have capacity to allow permits to proceed when FDR exceeds 'High'
- Need explicit approval of FWO.
