4 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES

5 REPORTS OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND OFFICERS

5.1 SAFE SPEEDS

5.1.1 SPEED RESTRICTION – LOWOOD ROAD

The request for a restricted speed of 40km/h within the Mount Barker town centre was discussed, in particular, Lowood Road from the Post Office to the Bakery.

Mr Lenton suggested the Shire put a case together with supporting documentation surrounding the request for reduced speeds on Lowood Road to submit to Main Roads WA for consideration.

Mr Hemmings advised that the Shire would provide a submission to Main Roads WA with a focus on Lowood Road.

5.2 SAFE ROAD USE

5.2.1 DRIVER REVIVER

Mr Hemmings provided an update on the Driver Reviver trailer that is currently being prepared for the wrap to be applied. The artwork has been sent to the State Roads Commission for approval, prior to being applied in early 2025.

Mr Lenton suggested the Committee consider taking the Driver Reviver trailer to Tunny, working in partnership with the food van currently using the Tunny pull in bay or alternatively inviting the food van to join them at Tenterden.

5.3 SAFE VEHICLES

5.4 SAFE ROADS AND ROADSIDES

Mr Hemmings advised that almost \$300,000 has been invested in mulching of roads for the 2024/2025 Road Construction programme to achieve the required standards.

Mr Hemmings reported that several concerns has been raised about the locations of the 40km/hr signs at the school crossing on Albany Highway.

Mr Lenton advised that the signs are temporary and will be replaced with the electronic speed limit signs (ESLS), being rolled out through the School Zones and Children's Crossings Improvement Program.

6 AGENCY REPORTS

6.1 ROADWISE

Michelle Blackhurst introduced herself to the Committee and outlined ways to assist the Shire and the Roadwise Committee working in areas such as grant funding and road safety audits.

Ms Blackhurst advised that the LG Stars programme is a safety rating tool for Local Governments that can help to provide another piece of evidence to assist with funding opportunities.

Mr Hemmings requested Ms Blackhurst schedule a visit to conduct a safety audit of Lowood Road in late January or early February 2025 and will provide the locations prior to the visit.

6.2 MAIN ROADS WA

Mr Lenton advised that work on Albany Highway is almost complete and no other major work is being done. Shoulder sealing work on Muir Highway is coming up and maintenance continues unabated.

Mr Lenton wished the Committee a Merry Christmas and safe travels on the roads.

6.3 MOUNT BARKER POLICE

Sqt Swain was an apology and no report submitted.

6.4 SHIRE OF PLANTAGENET

Mr Hemmings reported that reseals will be completed by Fulton Hogan after Christmas with a second coat seal on Eulup-Manurup Road and some of the smaller roads.

The clearing permit approval is expected in early 2025 for the preparation and sealing of Newman Road. O'Neill Road has been resheeted and will be sealed in 2025. Shoulder widening for Yellanup Road and failure's will be addressed on Woogenellup and Settlement Roads. Gravel resheets continue as part of the road construction programme for 2024/2025.

Mr Hemmings advised that works to Carbarup Road will complete the full extent of widening of this road in preparation for centre line marking.

6.5 MOUNT BARKER COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Mr Beck advised that Leanne Prior is currently the acting Principal at the Mount Barker Community College.

6.6 COMMUNITY MEMBER

Mrs Drage did not present a report.

6.7 MOUNT BARKER COMMUNITY COLLEGE P & C
